How to print poster size:

You have two different options to print this (or any other PDF) poster size.

- 1) Have an architectural print (sometimes called engineering prints) made at Staples or your local copy center. It's super-cheap, a few different sizes are available, and you can often get one made for less than \$5.
- 2) Open the document in Adobe Reader and adjust the Tile Scale. By default, the scale is set to 100% (8.5 x 11") Increase the percentage and the finished product will get larger! Not sure how large to make the scale? The preview on the right side of the box will give you a sense of how large the finished poster will be.

Your printer will print paper “tiles” that you can attach the edges with a glue stick (you’ll basically be using the printed papers like puzzle pieces) to create a finished poster.

This is tedious and takes a lot of patience, but it does pay off. I like to increase the overlap to .5” so I have a wider margin to work with when I glue the edges together.

I like to print my pages on cardstock so they are extra durable.
